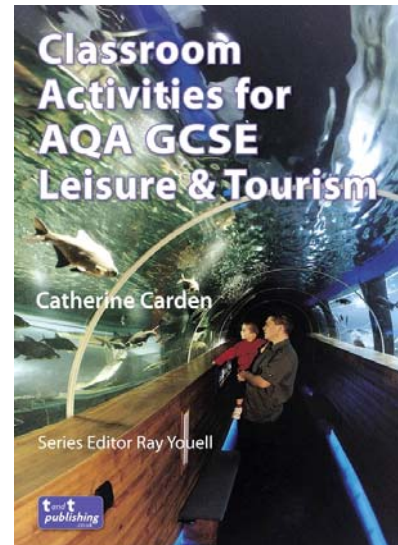
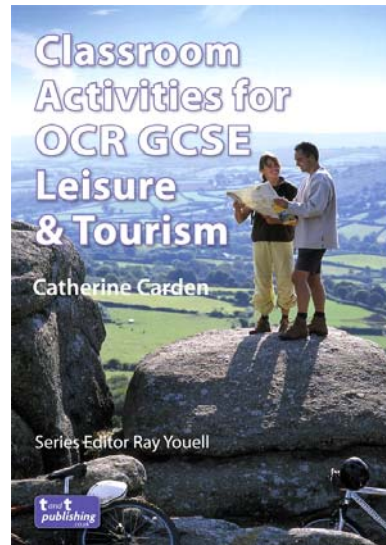
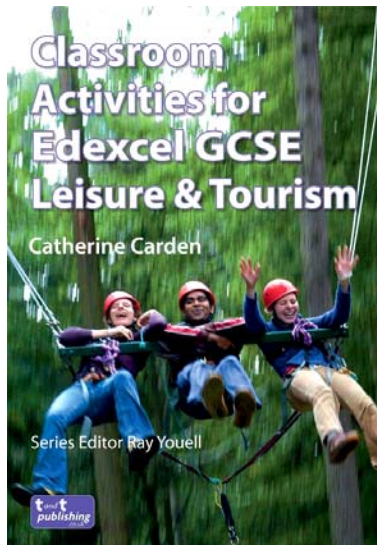


Travel & Tourism Publishing announces a new book series for the revised GCSE Leisure & Tourism specifications
